

We are at the start of a fun new season here at Lake Marie! We would like to welcome all our new members, and wish the best to those who have left.

### SALE OF PROPERTY:

A reminder to members selling property, please let the office know you have sold property and to whom. Also, please let the buyer know they must register the property in the office.

All dues, fines, liens, and fees will be attached to the property owner of record.

Please make sure your property deeds have been transferred and recorded both with Mercer County and the Lake Marie Office.

THERE WILL BE 3 LMPOA BOARD SEATS OPEN FOR THE SEPTEMBER ELECTION. IF YOU ARE INTERESTED IN RUNNING, PLEASE PICK UP A FORM AT THE OFFICE. FORMS ARE DUE BEFORE JULY 12, 2025 TO BE ON THE BALLOT. IF YOU ARE INTERESTED IN RUNNING FOR A BOARD POSITION, WE ASK THAT YOU ATTEND THE AUGUST MEETING SO YOU MAY SHARE WHO YOU ARE, AND THE REASONS YOU ARE RUNNING FOR THE BOARD.

### Spraying the weeds in the lake was successful.

Lake rules state that property owners are responsible for weeds, trees, and brush control on their property all the way out to the road. This includes overhanging bushes and trees extending into/over the roadway. We are asking that property owners remove or trim said weeds, trees, and brush beyond road way for safety purposes of roadways; failure to do so will result in maintenance doing the work and the property owner being charged for the service. Please do your part as our time is going to be at your expense.

July 4<sup>th</sup> is right around the corner; we are currently accepting donations for fireworks. You can make donations at the office. The festivities will start with kids games at 2:30 pm, July 5<sup>th</sup> at the Clubhouse. The parade will start lining up at 6:30 pm. Fireworks will be done off the dam at dark.

REMINDER: WE DO TAKE CREDIT CARDS! (Yes, there is a small fee)

## GENERAL REMINDERS:

- Property Owners are to mow a minimum of twice a month during the growing season (April October) all the way to the road, and this includes trimming back trees, weeds, and brush.
- Property owners are responsible for their family members and guests.
- The speed limit on lake roads is 15 MPH. This applies to all motorized vehicles.
- No dogs on the beach. Pets are to be contained or always leashed. Please do not let your pets wander loose.
- Travel in a counter clockwise direction on the Lake, even when fishing.
- Remember to close the marina gate immediately after putting your boat in or taking your boat out
  of the water.
- DO NOT give out the marina gate combination to non-paying members or non-members.
- All recreational vehicles (land and water) MUST have a current Lake Marie sticker to travel on Lake Marie Property. Recreational Vehicles include but are not limited to gators, ATVs, and golf carts. All motorized watercrafts need a Lake Marie sticker to be on any of the Lake Marie lakes/ponds.
- Do not tie your boat or floating device up to buoys and/or other members' docks.
- NO SWIMMING ALLOWED IN THE MARINA!
- <u>SWIMMING IN THE MIDDLE OF THE LAKE IS NOT ALLOWED. SWIMMING IS TO BE</u>
  <u>DONE IN THE COVES OR BEACH AREAS ONLY!</u> When docked in a cove, be sure to respect the rights of the members who live in the cove (No Loud and Obnoxious language or gestures).
- Burn as much as possible. Do not place cardboard in the dumpsters.
- Non-holiday wake hours are 10 AM to 8 PM and holiday weekend wake hours are 9 AM to 8 PM.
   This includes all watercraft.
- Please keep your contact information up-to-date with the Lake Marie office. You can do so by stopping in during office hours, calling, or by sending an email or regular mail.
- COMMUNITY AREAS AND BEACHES ARE CLOSED AT SUNDOWN.
- NO FIREWORKS AT THE MARINA OR BEACHES. FIREWORKS NEED TO BE DONE BY 11:00 PM.
- All motorized vehicle drivers must be 16 years old, unless accompanied by an adult.
- **DUMPSTERS**: Use of dumpsters continues to be an issue. THE DUMPSTERS ARE FOR BAGGED GARBAGE ONLY!! If this continues being a problem, we may lose the only Dumpster company that serves Mercer County.
  - NO CONSTRUCTION MATERIAL, TVS, MATTRESSES, METAL, PLASTIC TOYS, FURNITURE, CARPET, ETC.!!
  - If you are doing a remodel, demolition, cleanout, or any other major project, please rent a dumpster by calling Rapid Removal @ 660-654-4287. Burn your cardboard and paper products.
